- Program Enrollment: Students interested in working toward the Certificate in Sports Law & Policy typically enroll in the program *after completing one year of law school*. Enrollment forms are available online at <http://www.tjssl.edu/sports-law-policy>.
- Units Requirement: Certificate candidates must earn a total of at least *twelve (12) elective units* from a of CSLP-eligible graded classroom courses or from eligible TJSL non-classroom units and three (3) units in an approved internship, for a minimum total of fifteen (15) units.
- Participation Requirement: Students enrolled in the program and working toward a Certificate must show a reasonable, good faith level of participation in CSLP-related events and activities. Candidates must report and summarize their activities when applying for the Certificate.
- Writing and GPA Requirements: Under the supervision of a faculty member certificate candidates must fulfill a Substantial Writing Requirement relating to a subject matter relevant to CSLP. The same paper may fulfill both the Substantial Writing Requirement and the law school's general Upper Level Writing Requirement. Certificate candidates admitted to law school in the Fall 2009 or later semester must graduate with at least a 2.5 overall GPA and at least a 2.7 Center GPA.
- Certificate Application: Candidates for the Certificate in Sports Law & Policy, who are enrolled and participating in the program, must submit an application form at the start of their last semester of law school.
