

Facts & Figures about the TJSL Fall 2011 Incoming Class

- 350 students (290 Full-time and 60 Part-time)
- 45% are students of color
- 5% of the class self-identified as GLBT (Gay Lesbian Bisexual or Transgender)
- 40 are active duty, reserve or veteran status military personnel with Army, Marines, Navy, Air Force and Coast Guard represented
- Born in 23 different countries including Azerbaijan, the Bahamas, Canada, Ethiopia, Germany, India, Iran, Turkey, Japan, Korea, Lebanon, Mexico, Netherlands, Nigeria, Pakistan, the Philippines, Serbia, Taiwan, the UK, Vietnam, South Korea, Colombia and the U.S.
- 43% speak at least one other language including Arabic, Armenian, Cambodian, Cantonese,
 Chinese, English, Ethiopian, Farsi, French, German, Greek, Gujarati, Hindi, Japanese, Korean,
 Portuguese, Punjabi, Russian, Serbian, Spanish, Tagalog, Turkish and Vietnamese.
- 51% are coming from outside California
- Gender balanced at 52% male/48% female.
- They come from 151 different undergrad institutions
- Average age 26
- 28 grew up in rurally isolated areas. 62 attended a minority isolated group high school. They have 54 different majors from nuclear engineering to drama.
- 24% are the first in their families to attend college;
- 53% are the first in their families to attend grad school.
