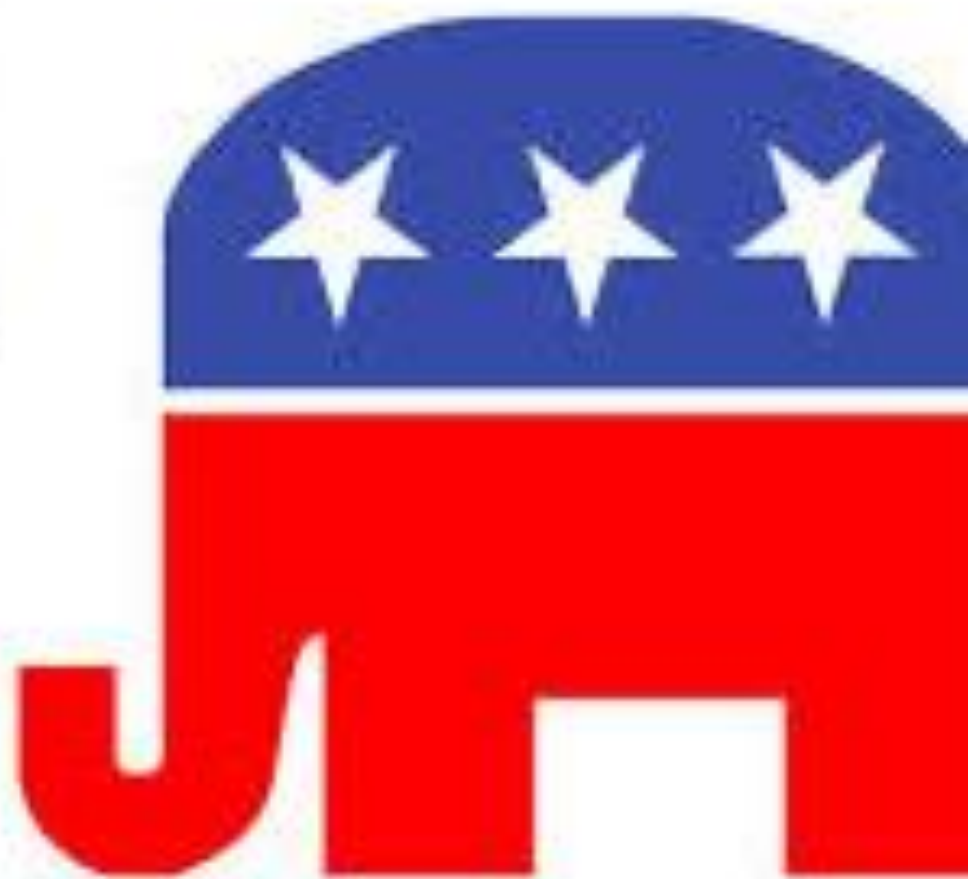

Series of Firsts



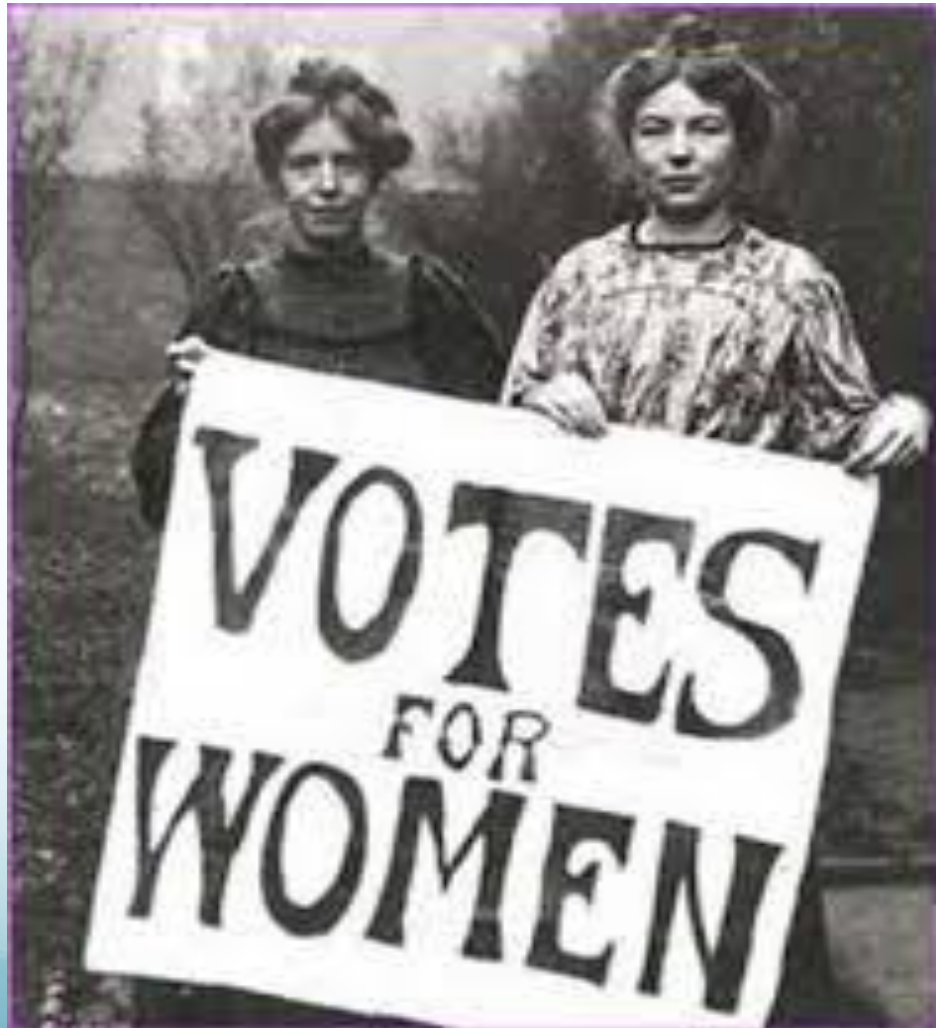
- First Woman to be admitted to Hastings School.

- First Woman to run for Governor of California.



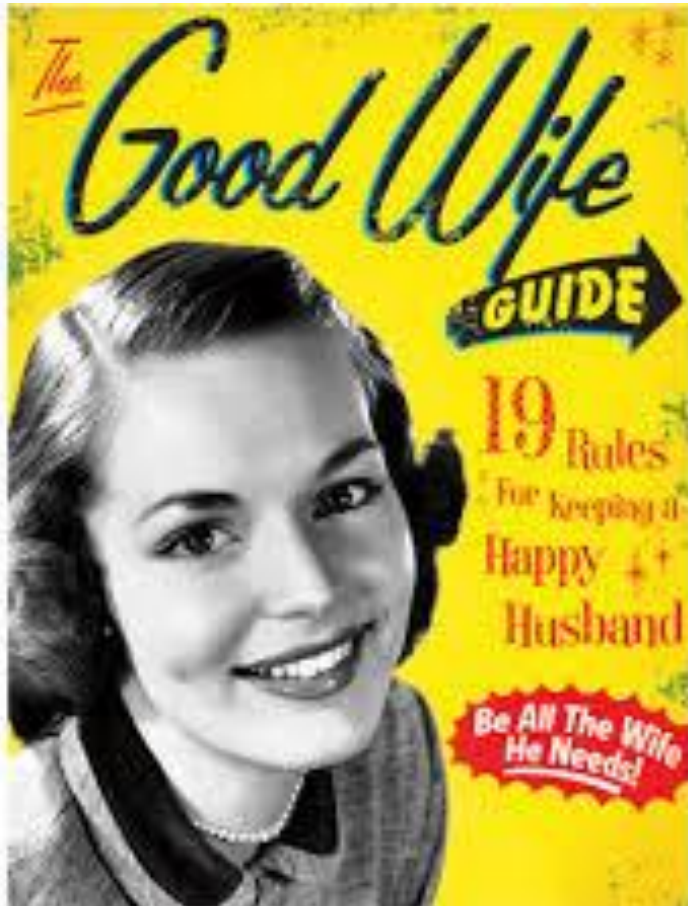

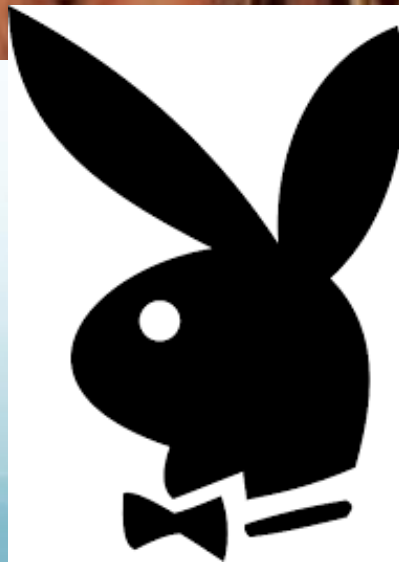
